BEST OF THE BEST IMPRESSION MATERIALS

Five impression materials highly rated by THE DENTAL ADVISOR are compared to determine the "Best of the Best." The impression materials were regular-set addition silicones with two viscosities, putty and injectable light body. The ratings, as previously determined by THE DENTAL ADVISOR, are shown in *Table 1*.

"Best of the Best" Criteria

Both viscosities were evaluated and rated on a 1-5 scale (1 = poor, 5 = excellent).

Putty

- Ease of mixing Easy to incorporate base and catalyst
- Lack of stickiness Does not stick to fingers or scoops
- Flows at seat Not stiff, flows and adapts to teeth and trays
- Blending of light body and putty Blends well with light body without displacing it completely

Light Body

- Viscosity/flow Extrudes easily from cartridge
- Stackability Flows well, but stacks; not runny
- Color differentiation Good color contrast between putty and light body allows for easy reading of margins
- Lack of voids/porosity Hydrophilic, adapts to preparation well; no voids or air bubbles

Clinical Protocol

Twenty impressions were made by consultants using each of the impression materials listed in *Table 1*. The outlined characteristics of the putty and light body were rated on a scale of 1-5, and the values were averaged as shown in *Table 2*. Listed below are the final rankings of each viscosity.

Summary

The five impression materials were highly rated by THE DENTAL ADVISOR in individual clinical evaluations. While all are excellent materials, the objective of this evaluation was to select the "Best of the Best." Consultants found that *Virtual* regular-set putty was the easiest to mix, lacked stickiness and was least difficult to form in the tray and seat. The deep blue color is excellent for visual clarity of detail. *Flexitime* regular-set light body stacks well and flows evenly over the preparation, creating minimal voids or porosities. The bright green color allows for very good clarity of margin detail. As a putty and light body combination, consultants identified *Flexitime* as the "Best of the Best." Final impressions taken with *Flexitime* provide the most detail, least voids and best visualization of anatomy.
