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# **BEST OF THE BEST PROVISIONAL MATERIALS**

Five composite provisional materials were highly rated by THE DENTAL ADVISOR in individual clinical evaluations. These materials are now being compared to determine the *Best of the Best.* The ratings, as given at the time of each product's original evaluation, are shown in *Table 1*.

## **Clinical Protocol**

Clinical consultants prepared 19 to 33 provisional restorations using each of the materials listed in *Table 1*. The characteristics were scored on a scale of 1 to 5 (1 = poor, 5 = excellent).

#### **Results**

The scores for each of the 13 characteristics evaluated and the overall average score for each composite provisional material are listed in *Table 2*.



### Summary

While all are considered excellent materials, the objective of this evaluation was to select the *Best of the Best.* **Luxatemp** was awarded the *Best of the Best of the Best* based on its outstanding clinical characteristics, including the highest score for viscosity, setting time, no residue left on the teeth, lack of an air-inhibited layer, quality of polish and esthetics, and fit.

*Editors' Note:* The scores for the three products tied for second place are not statistically different.



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
