



2025 PROGRAM FEES

IMPORTANT

- 1. Historically, the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada (CDAC) has published a five-year program fee schedule. The current fee schedule is only valid for 2025 due to the plan to establish a new funding model with its funding partners in 2025.
- 2. The 2025 fee schedule aligns with the approximate 20% fee increase to regulators issued in 2024 and has not been increased for the 2025 year.
- 3. It is the objective of the CDAC Board to publish a multi-year program fee schedule later in 2025.
- 4. Fees for 2024 are included in this document for reference only.

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This document has been designed and prepared to assist institutions to easily understand the process by which the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada (CDAC) administers the financial aspects of the accreditation process. As well, the document serves as a blueprint to assist institutions plan for future expenditures.

The past, current, or future accreditation status of a dental program or service has no bearing upon the fees to be paid. Only a lapse or withdrawal of accreditation status would result in an interruption in the process; and therefore, the institution would be charged the fee for an initial site visit when the dental program or service is surveyed once again.

It is to be noted that the "annual" cycle fees are calculated based on:

- seven (7) years for publicly funded educational programs in dentistry, dental specialties, dental assisting, and dental hygiene
- five (5) years for health facility dental services and hospital dental internship or residency programs, and
- four (4) years for educational programs offered by a private institution.

Note: This fee schedule is subject to change or termination by CDAC at any time without notice.

Dental Assisting Programs in Ontario and Quebec

In jurisdictions where regulatory authority contributions are not provided, dental assisting programs, requesting an accreditation survey, are required to pay an initial site visit fee. The fee is based on a formula determined by CDAC, which represents the costs of conducting a site visit added to a percentage of administrative costs assigned to preparing and reviewing the accreditation survey report. Fees are invoiced by CDAC prior to the site visit. For additional information on the specific formula, please contact CDAC.

New Dental/Dental Specialty/Dental Hygiene/Dental Assisting Programs - Publicly Funded Programs

A new publicly funded educational program requesting initial accreditation is required to pay the initial site visit fee shown in Chart V. Fees are invoiced by CDAC prior to the site visit.

The second accreditation survey of a new program occurs three years from the date of the initial survey, when the program is eligible for re-survey. During the year of the second survey, the program is required to pay a new site visit fee as shown in Chart V. Once surveyed a second time, the program is invoiced annually.

Accredited Programs in Private Institutions

New Program - Private Institution

A new private educational program requesting initial accreditation is required to pay the initial site visit fee shown in Chart VI. Fees are invoiced by CDAC prior to the site visit.

The second accreditation survey of a new private program occurs two years from the date of the initial survey, when the program is eligible for re-survey. During the year of the second survey, the program is required to pay a new site visit fee as shown in Chart VI. Once surveyed a second time, the program is invoiced annually.

Annual Payment Plan

The annual payment plan is an administrative tool to help institutions plan for future expenditures.

Accredited educational programs pay an annual fee to CDAC which is invoiced annually, in January, according to Chart VII.

Health Facility Dental Services

Health facilities pay their accreditation fee prior to each site visit as indicated in Chart IX.

The site visit necessitates that the accreditation survey team examine each health facility site. Therefore, the program is charged according to the number of sites.

Hospital and Non-Hospital-Based Dental Residency Programs

New Program

A new dental residency program, requesting accreditation for the first time, is required to pay the initial site visit fee shown in Chart X.

The site visit necessitates that the accreditation survey team examine each health facility site through which a hospital dental internship or residency program rotates. Therefore, the program is charged according to the number of health facility sites.

The second accreditation survey of a new residency program occurs five years from the date of the initial survey, when the program is eligible for re-survey. During the year of the second survey, the program is required to pay a new site visit fee as shown in Chart X. Once surveyed a second time, the program is invoiced annually.

Annual Payment Plan

The annual payment plan is an administrative tool to help institutions plan for future expenditures.

Accredited educational programs pay an annual fee to CDAC which is invoiced annually, in January, according to Chart XI.

A dental internship or residency program, that declines the opportunity to participate in the annual payment plan, is invoiced prior to each site visit, based on the fees shown in Chart X.
